Your Utility Bill from the City

The City provides water, sewer, garbage pickup, and centralized recycling, all included on one monthly bill. Utility bills are mailed on the first of the month and are due by the 20th. After the 20th, you will be assessed a \$10 late fee. Utility bills that are unpaid by the 30th of the month are subject to a \$50 fee and disconnection. ACH/Direct Payment and online bill pay available, please ask for details.



Water: Minimum charge of \$28.62 for up to 2000 gallons. \$6.48 per 1000 gallons over initial 2000 gallons.

Sewer: Minimum charge of \$25.60 for up to 2000 gallons. \$3.40 per 1000 gallons over initial 2000 gallons.



Garbage: \$9.5 per month. Picked up each Thursday before 6 am. Please place your bagged garbage in a 35 gallon (or smaller) container at the curb on Wednesday evening.



Recycling/Landfill: \$7 per month. A large community recycling container is located north of the water tower on Main Street. Please follow all posted sorting guidelines. Do not leave any non-recyclable or oversized items on the ground. Curbside recycling is not available.

Pet Licensing



The City requires that all cats & dogs 6 months or older be vaccinated against rabies and licensed with the City. Licenses are valid from January 1st through December 31st and are just \$2 per animal, up to 4 animals and then \$10 per animal after 4. Please obtain your pet licenses from City Hall by providing a current rabies vaccination certificate.

Building Permits



Building permits are required for a variety of home and property improvements. Please contact City Hall for more information and a permit before you begin your project.

Community Center & Tornado Shelter
