2025 Pet Licenses Available

If you own a dog or a cat, you are REQUIRED to license them with the city. You must provide proof of current rabies vaccination (not to expire before June 30) along with \$2 for each license. Pet licenses are valid from January 1st to December 31st each year and are required for ALL cats & dogs. **2025 licenses are now available at City Hall.** If you can not come into City Hall, please mail or drop off the **rabies vaccination certificate** (not an invoice for veterinary services) for each animal along with \$2 per license. The license will be issued and mailed back to you along with your original vaccination certificates. If you do not have a copy of the vaccination certificate, contact your veterinarian for a copy. No licenses will be issued if the vaccination certificate does not accompany the payment. DO NOT add the cost of the licenses to your water bill payment. Please call City Hall for more details.
