## **Building Permits**

With Spring just around the corner, now is the time to start thinking about home improvement projects. If you have a project planned, please call City Hall to find out if you need a permit. Permits for most general repair, fence, deck or shed building under 120 sq. ft., and cement work are just \$25. All building permits are valid for 1 year from date of issuance.



### **Lawn Mowing**

When mowing, please do NOT blow grass clippings into the street. While it is important to keep your lawn maintained, it is also important to keep the streets clear as well. Grass clippings as well as other debris on the road are a hazard to pedestrians, bicyclists, and motorcyclists and constitute a violation of City Code and in some cases, Iowa Code (321.369).

3-1-7.2 Putting glass, etc., on streets and sidewalks. No person shall throw or deposit on any street or sidewalk any glass bottle, glass, nails, tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal, or any other debris, or any other substance likely to injure any person, animal or vehicle.
