Survey— Your Response is REQUIRED

The City of Duncombe is required to do a rehabilitation project for the lagoons. One of the ways to help offset some of the cost of this project is to receive a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), up to \$500,000, through the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA). In order to submit a grant application, a Low-to-Moderate Income survey must be completed within the city. MIDAS Council of Governments will be sending an income survey to the majority of the homes in Duncombe and we need **every single survey returned by the deadline**. Keep an eye out in your mail for the survey over the next couple of weeks. It takes two minutes to complete and there is no personal identifying information on the survey. Thank you in advance for your cooperation!

Winter Reminders

As winter approaches, please keep these things in mind:

Garbage- Keep your garbage containers back from the road during the winter. Set them out for the designated pick up day and then put them back near your house/garage. Containers that are too close to the road or blow into the road cause issues with the plows or the containers may get hit.

Water Meters— Be sure to keep snow and other debris away from your water meter readout on the outside of your home so there is an unobstructed path to access to the meter readouts every month.
